What does it mean to be complacent about God?

THE PROPHET ZEPHANIAH  
Zephaniah 1:12; 2:3; 3:17,  
Luke 15:3-7

Zephaniah warned the people that God would punish them for behaving as if God was unimportant to them. He gave them the choice to seek God. Zephaniah told them of God's promises for those who would seek Him. He said, "Your God is with you. He is mighty to save. He will take great delight in you, and quiet you with His love. He will rejoice over you with singing!"
