DANIEL'S FRIENDS AND THE FIERY FURNACE
Daniel 3:12-30; 4:3

King Nebuchadnezzar made a law that when the music played, everyone in Babylon must bow to worship his golden idol. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego refused, so they were thrown into a fiery furnace. In the fire, the king saw an extra man who looked like the son of a god. The three men came out unharmed. The king said, "No other god can save in this way."
