HAGGAI AND ZECHARIAH
Haggai 1:7-9; 2:4, 9, 23

God sent Haggai and Zechariah to encourage those returning from Babylon with Zerubbabel to rebuild Jerusalem. Haggai warned them to give careful thought to their ways.
